A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALIPATRIA  
AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR CDBG HOUSING REHABILITATION WORK

**WHEREAS**, the City of Calipatria has a current and active Housing Rehabilitation Program, under an adopted Program Income Reuse Plan, where funds are authorized to be used for eligible housing projects from the Revolving Loan Account for the benefit of low- and moderate-income families; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Calipatria Loan Committee has qualified a project from an eligible participant for a housing rehabilitation loan/grant project per the adopted Housing Rehabilitation Guidelines; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the costs associated with the project include the rehabilitation of an ADA compliant handicap bathroom, carport and front porch for an elderly low-income household unit located at **170 E. Church Street**; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the rehabilitation project was publicly posted for bid and a qualified bid was received by **Trademark Construction**, an eligible contractor, who's bid has been accepted as satisfactory by the qualified participant and the City of Calipatria; *and*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Calipatria will have sufficient funds in the Housing Rehabilitation RLA Account to cover the aforementioned project costs in a not to exceed loan amount of **\$8,221.00** and grant amount of **\$5,000.00** for a total project cost of **\$13,221.00**; *and*
