A public hearing has been posted in order to discuss possible Program Income Waiver under the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and to solicit citizen input on possible activities to be included in the waiver. Eligible activities under the above allocations in the CDBG program consist of: 1) Homeownership assistance and housing rehabilitation programs; 2) Public facility and public improvements projects (including public improvements in support of new housing construction); 3) Public service programs, planning studies, economic development business assistance and microenterprise activities. Eligible activities paid for with State CDB funds must meet one or more of the three national objectives listed in CDBG federal statutes as follows: benefit to low income household or person; elimination of slums and blight; or meeting urgent community development need.

The City of Calipatria is planning on submitting a waiver request for the repairs to the Delta Street Sewer Line Repair Project based on Urgent Need. Estimated costs of CDBG funds would be \$165,100.00. The City of Calipatria has or anticipates receiving approximately \$1,131,989.00 in CDBG Program Income that must be expended prior to expending awarded grant funds. The purpose of this public hearing is to give

citizens an opportunity to make their comments known regarding the proposed application above by the City of Calipatria under the State CDBG Program Income Waiver.
