WHEREAS, October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month, which is an annual campaign to increase awareness of breast cancer and encourage annual mammography screenings; and

WHEREAS, when breast cancer is detected early and is in the localized stage, the fiveyear survival rate for women is 99%; and

WHEREAS, there are many organizations that continue working to find better ways to prevent, detect, and treat breast cancer, and to improve the quality of life of patients and survivors; and

WHEREAS, it is important to celebrate breast cancer survivors and to remember those lost to this disease;

NOW THEREFORE, we, the City of Calipatria City Council, do hereby proclaim October 2025 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month and encourage all citizens to increase their awareness of breast cancer, the importance of early detection, and the advancements in breast cancer treatment.

Background:

The city has been allocated \$100,000.00 for fiscal year 2023/2024 and \$106,695.99 for fiscal year 2023/2024 Growth from the State of California Citizens Options for Public Safety (COPS) Program. The Police Department is requesting continued funding for the Full-time Limited Term Police Officer position, Training, Overtime, and Equipment.

To accept the funds, the City is required to adopt a resolution that identifies the uses for those funds. The resolutions are attached.
